It is hereby agreed by the placer, STRAY NO MORE. INC., and the adopter of the above-named animal that:

1. PATIENCE. These animals were homeless, stray, or abused, so many are fearful of being left behind again. Most animals, within a few days, will blossom and love you more than you can imagine. Realize you will need to help the animal ADJUST to his/her new life.
2. A RESCUE I.D. tag, which includes the adopter's name, address and phone number must be on the pet at ALL times. A rabies tag is fine, but doesn't cover the above.
3. Dogs should be WALKED daily on a leash every day (minimum recommended time is 30 minutes).
4. No dog is EVER to be let out to relieve itself where ever it wants to roam!
5. NO dog is ever to be chained or tied outside, or inside!
6. Spend quality time daily with your pet.
7. No dog shall ever be an outdoor pet. The only time the animals should be outside is when the owner is within eye and ear sight of the pet.
8. If you have a fence, maintain it accordingly to prevent any escape.
9. Dogs must be let out to RELIEVE themselves within 8 hours; 9 hours or longer would be considered abuse.
10. Beware of people who would steal your pet to sell for animal experimentation (Bunchers), dog fights, or satanic rituals. Yes, this happens often in West Palm Beach. Protect your pet as you would a child.
11. Find a good veterinarian. Realize that all pets cost money and emergencies DO happen. Be prepared.
12. Plan ahead for your pet if a HURRICANE approaches. The Red Cross shelters do not allow animals. No pet is ever to be left behind when you evacuate. And we hope EVERYONE evacuates, even if you have shutters. Just look at Homestead!
13. Provide for your pet in the unlikely occasion that you should predecease your pet, either by Will or by Instruction to your family or close reliable friends. Do not leave this responsibility to a person that does not love your pet. Would you want it dumped at a shelter, or pound?
14. Dog must have HEARTWORM PREVENTATIVE monthly.
15. FLEA problems need to be under control.
16. No animal shall be hit for any reason.
17. If you HAVE adopted a puppy/kitten you have to keep it on its vaccination schedule provided by our vet.
18. No animals should ride in the back of a truck, even if it is double tethered. No animals shall ever be left unattended in a parked automobile.
19. Adopter will provide proper nutrition, water and veterinary care for the animal.
20. If the animal is lost, adopter will contact the placer immediately for assistance in recovery. Adopter will keep photograph of the animal for identification purposes.
21. Adopter will keep in touch with the placer and allow a follow-up visit as part of the standard adoption follow-up procedure.
22. The adopted animal is to be a family pet only. Adoption these animals under false pretense will result in legal action.
23. If in the future, the adopter breaks this contract and is unable to care for the pet, owner shall notify Stray No More, Inc. Stray No More, Inc. will, if possible, assist in finding the dog a new home. However, the owner will need to pay for the boarding of the animal until a foster home is found. The

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- dog shall not be abandoned, sold or given to a shelter without notifying Stray No More, Inc.
24. Failure to fulfill any of the above conditions will constitute a breach of the Agreement and will authorize Stray No More, Inc. to reclaim the adopted pet and/or take further legal action.
 25. Stray No More, Inc. is held free of liability with respect to the newly placed animal but is responsible for reclaiming it if the best interests of the animal are no longer being met.
 26. Stray No More, Inc. is not responsible for any undiagnosed medical problem that may have been present prior to adoption.

RETURN POLICY OF ADOPTED ANIMALS FROM STRAY NO MORE, INC.

1. If an animal is returned within 2 weeks from adoption, a complete refund of money will be given to the owners. We will take the animal immediately back into a foster home, or board at a vet. at our responsibility.
2. If an animal has been adopted past 2 weeks until ? years, Stray No More, Inc. will give every type of assistance needed to help that animal find a new home. Since we do not have a facility, money, or volunteers required to have an open door policy for the hundreds of animals adopted since August 1994, the following policies need to be followed:
 - a). If an animal has bitten a person, we will be unable to adopt that pet through our organization. You need to have the pet evaluated by a trainer (we can recommend great trainers) to see if the animal is aggressive to adults. It may just be children the animal cannot be around, thus you could find it a home away from children. If it is deemed aggressive towards adults, the pet will have to be euthanized.
 - b). If an animal is being returned because of any other reason, *the owners need to be able to foster the pet until Stray No More can find a foster home*; or if you choose, pay for the boarding at a vet's office (\$10.00 a day). We cannot automatically take the animal into a foster home, as we do not have enough foster homes available for the stray animals, nor can we afford to board the pet. Stray No More will pay to advertise in the paper, and/or have you bring the pet to Pet Smart for adoption. You will sign an "owner release agreement", and stray No More, Inc. will interview, conduct the house check, etc. as well as receive the adoption fee.
 - c) When you were interviewed, you signed a statement saying you would provide fur the pet for a lifetime. We trusted your answer. Remember, if you are giving up your pet, you are responsible for the animal until we are able, if we are able, to take the pet back into our organization.

REMEMBER, ADOPTION OF AN ANIMAL IS A SERIOUS COMMITMENT!!! BE SURE YOU ARE COMPLETELY READY FOR A LIFETIME, otherwise DO NOT ADOPT THIS ANIMAL.
